STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of bridge across the Umcolcus Stream
in Oxbow Plantation, Aroostook County.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of twelve hundred dollars (\$1200) to aid in constructing a
3 bridge across the Umcolcus Stream in Oxbow plantation,
4 county of Aroostook; provided there be appropriated by
5 Oxbow plantation, the county of Aroostook, or otherwise,
6 the sum of twelve hundred dollars (\$1200) for the same
7 purpose, both sums to be expended under the supervision of
8 the State Highway Department.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Umcolcus Stream flows into the Aroostook River through Oxbow plantation in the county of Aroostook. The present bridge is nearly worn out and a new bridge is needed. This bridge is a part of a road leading westerly from Oxbow to the lakes and great lumber woods west of Oxbow and is extensively used by lumbermen and sportsmen. It is a much used road. The bridge will be about 50 feet long and about 15 feet above the bed of the stream. The population in 1910, is given as 181, polls 63. The assessors' valuation for 1912 of real and personal estates including non-resident lands is \$64,222.
