STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in aid of building a bridge across Sandy Stream in
the Plantation of Lexington.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) to aid in the building of a
3 bridge across Sandy stream on the "East" road, so-called,
4 in the plantation of Lexington, county of Somerset, pro-
5 vided there be appropriated by said plantation of Lexington
6 or otherwise the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for
7 the same purpose; both sums to be expended under the su-
8 pervision of the State Highway Department.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The plantation of Lexington has a large road mileage and many bridges to maintain. It is in debt to the limit and has a high rate of taxation.
