STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of aid in building a bridge across Passa-
dumkeag Stream in Grand Falls Plantation.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of five hundred dollars (\$500) to aid in building a bridge
3 across Passadumkeag Stream in the plantation of Grand
4 Falls, county of Penobscot, provided there be appropriated
5 by the county of Penobscot, or otherwise, the sum of five
6 hundred dollars (\$500) for the same purpose; both sums
7 to be expended in such manner as may be directed by the
8 State Highway Department.

STATEMENT OF FACT.

The county road stops at the westerly end of the bridge, thus leaving the entire burden of the expense of the bridge to be borne by a few individuals, chiefly lumbermen, who do business in the Nicatous Lake region, to which this road is the main **thoroughfare and a large amount of sporting traffic** also passes over this bridge in season.
