#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 13 of Chapter four of the Revised Statutes as amended by Chapter 200 of the Laws of 1909.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 13 of Chapter four of the Revised Stat
2 utes as amended by Chapter 200 of the Public Laws of 1909

3 is hereby amended by striking out between the word "elect"

4 in the first line of said section and the word "by" in the third

5 line the following words: "and all towns with over sixty
6 five hundred inhabitants shall elect", so that said section 13

7 of Chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes as amended shall read

8 as follows:

'Sect. 13. Each town at its annual meeting may elect by no major vote a road commissioner, who shall hold his office for the term of one year from the date of his election. Any town may, at its option, elect not more than three commissioners, whose powers and duties shall be the same as presupposed for a single commissioner. No person shall, at the same time, hold the office of road commissioner and selection.'
