STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 13 of Chapter four of the Revised
Statutes as amended by Chapter 200 of the Laws of 1909.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 13 of Chapter four of the Revised Statutes as amended by Chapter 200 of the Public Laws of 1909 is hereby amended by striking out between the word "elect" in the first line of said section and the word "by" in the third line the following words: "and all towns with over sixty-five hundred inhabitants shall elect", so that said section 13 of Chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes as amended shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 13. Each town at its annual meeting may elect by
10 major vote a road commissioner, who shall hold his office
11 for the term of one year from the date of his election. Any
12 town may, at its option, elect not more than three commis-
13 sioners, whose powers and duties shall be the same as pre-
14 scribed for a single commissioner. No person shall, at the
15 same time, hold the office of road commissioner and select-
16 man.’
