STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to the disbursement of appropriations to
institutions receiving state aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No institution which accepts persons for medi-
2 cal or surgical treatment and whose financial affairs are not
3 wholly under the control of this state, shall receive from
4 the state treasury any appropriation made by the legislature,
5 nor any part thereof, until the state auditor shall be satisfied
6 that its per capita per diem charge for service is not less
7 than the cost of such service; but nothing in this act shall be
8 construed to prevent the acceptance by any institution of a

9 less sum than the face of the bill in payment of the same
10 from those judged by the managers to be unable to pay the
11 full amount, nor the performance of gratuitous service for
12 those deemed worthy.
