STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to authorize the City Council of the city of Belfast
to grant permission to Mathews Brothers to construct and
maintain a Suspension Bridge over and across Front street
in said Belfast.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The city council of the city of Belfast may, on such terms
2 and conditions as they think proper, grant to Mathews
3 Brothers, a corporation duly organized and existing under
4 the laws of the State of Maine, its legal representatives
5 and assigns, a license to construct and maintain a suspen-
6 sion bridge, from a building on its own land on the south-
7 erly side of Front street in said Belfast, above and across
8 said Front street to another building on its own land on the

9 northerly side of said Front street, of such height above said
10 Front street, and of such character that the same, in the
11 judgment of the said city council, will not incommode the
12 public in the use of said street for purposes of public travel;
13 and such bridge, construed by virtue of the license granted
14 as aforesaid, shall not be considered an incumbrance or
15 nuisance in such street.
