STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 30 of the Private and Special Laws of 1911 authorizing the Wiscasset, Waterville and Farmington Railway Company to dispose of a part of the property of said Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. Chapter 30 of the Private and Special Laws
2 of 1911 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following
3 section:

'Sect. 4. Said Wiscasset, Waterville and Farmington 5 Railway Company shall have a period of two years within

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6 which the power and authority conferred by this chapter 7 may be exercised and such power and authority if not exer-8 cised during such period shall thereupon cease and deter-9 mine.'
