IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to Good Templars Hall in Dexter.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That the selectmen of Dexter are authorized
2 to convey to Plymouth Lodge of Odd Fellows of Dexter,
3 Maine, No. 65, said lodge being a corporate body organized
4 for benevolent and fraternal purposes, all their interest as
5 trustees or otherwise in that building in said Dexter which
6 contains the Good Templars hall formerly so called, known
7 as Temperance hall, including their interest in the lot on
8 which it stands. Said hall shall be kept in good repair by
9 said lodge and the obligation to keep said building in repair

10 so far as it now rests on said selectmen or said inhabitants
11 of Dexter is to be assumed by said lodge. The trustees of
12 said lodge are given full power to use and manage the same
13 in any proper way for the benefit of the cause of temper-
14 ance. The rights in and to the use of said hall by the Good
15 Templars or by the Women's Christian Temperance Union
16 of said Dexter as now existing shall remain.

Sect. 2. This act shall not be operative until the inhab-
2 itants of the town of Dexter shall assent hereto at a legally
3 called town meeting.
