STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the Brownfield Electric Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Charles E. Hill, Augusta A. Hill and Albert R.
2 Hill, their associates, successors and assigns are hereby
3 incorporated under the name of the Brownfield Electric
4 Company, for the purpose of making, generating, selling
5 and supplying electricity for lighting, heating, power, manu-
6 facturing or mechanical purposes in the towns of Brownfield,
7 Denmark and Hiram in the county of Oxford and the town
8 of Sebago in the county of Cumberland, or for any or either
9 of such purposes, and for distributing, supplying and sell-

10 ing electricity for any and all of said purposes to any cor-
11 poration, firm or individual within said towns desiring to
12 purchase the same, subject to the rights and liabilities in-
13 cident to similar corporations as fixed by the general
14 statutes relating thereto, provided, however, that said
15 Brownfield Electric Company shall not have authority to sell
16 or distribute electricity in said towns of Denmark or Hiram
17 without the consent of any other corporation, person or firm
18 engaged in such business or authorized to engage in such
19 business in said towns of Denmark or Hiram.

Section 2. Said corporation is authorized to locate, con-
2 struct and maintain a dam or dams on any brooks or streams
3 lying wholly or partly within said towns; provided, that
4 they shall not be constructed so the flowage of water will
5 interfere with any mills or dams existing at such time as
6 said company may erect dams as aforesaid.

Section 3. The capital stock of said corporation shall be
2 ten thousand dollars divided into shares of one hundred
3 dollars each, of such classes as the stockholders may deter-
4 mine, and it may issue bonds for such amounts as may be
5 required and secure said bonds by mortgages upon the prop-
6 erty and franchises of the company.

Section 4. Said corporation is hereby authorized to acquire
2 by purchase, plants, property, franchises, rights, privileges
3 and locations of other corporations or individuals engaged
4 in any of the kinds of business hereinbefore named in the
5 territory above mentioned, and such corporations and in-

6 dividuals are hereby authorized to convey, transfer and
7 assign such property, franchises, rights, privileges and loca-
8 tion to the said Brownfield Electric Company, and after the
9 acquisition of any such property by said Brownfield Electric
10 Company it shall have, hold, enjoy and exercise the same
11 for its own uses and purposes as though originally granted
12 to it.

Section 5. Said corporation is hereby authorized to con-
2 tract with any firm, individual or corporation for the pur-
3 pose of buying or selling power as the needs of its business
4 may require or permit.

Section 6. Said corporation is hereby authorized to set
2 poles and extend wires thereon in and through the streets
3 and ways in said towns of Brownfield, Denmark, Hiram and
4 Sebago, under the conditions aforesaid subject to the same
5 rights and liabilities incident to similar corporations as fixed
6 by the general statutes relating thereto.

Section 7. The first meeting of said corporation may be
2 called by written notice thereof, signed by any incorporator
3 herein named, served upon each incorporator by a copy of
4 the same in hand, or mailed, postage paid, at least seven
5 days prior to the day named therein for such meeting.
