STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Maine School for Feeble-Minded.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of fifteen thousand dollars, for the year nineteen hun-
3 dred and thirteen for the use of the Maine School for
4 Feeble-Minded.

For one brick building for women attendants, and that any
6 of the appropriation for the year nineteen hundred and thir-
7 teen remaining unexpended at the end of said year, may
8 be available for the year nineteen hundred and fourteen.

Said sum to be expended by the Hospital Trustees, under
10 the direction of the Governor and Council.
