### STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of aid in repairing the Lake Road in Oxford County.

Resolved. That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) for one year only for 3 the purpose of repairing the Lake road, so called, in Town-4 ship C and C Surplus in Oxford county; said appropriation to be expended under the supervision of the State High-6 way Department.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This road leads from the Byron road in the town of Andover to the south arm of Richardson lake, so called, and is about nine miles in length. There is no settlement on the road. The first two miles of it are in the town of Andover and the balance in Andover North Surplus and C township. The road where it leaves the south arm of Richardson lake is about four miles from Middle Dam, which is a noted sportsmen's and tourists' retreat. Steamers run from Middle Dam to the South Arm, where there is a small hotel or sportsmen's camp which is used to a great extent to entertain the public, and this is used by tourists with automobiles as well as teams with horses and is a great convenience to the tourists outside of Maine as well as the public in Maine.

This amount of money will put the road in comparatively good shape so that very little expense will be incurred in repairing hereafter.
