STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT additional to Chapter seventy-nine of the Revised Statutes, relating to transfer of actions and other matters to the Law Court in case of death of presiding justice.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. In case of physical or mental disability, death,
2 resignation, or removal of the justice presiding at any civil
3 or criminal proceeding before the supreme judicial or supe4 rior court, or at a hearing in equity, in which a motion for
5 new trial is made, exceptions presented or appeal taken, any
6 justice of the supreme judicial court may, upon motion, and

7 after notice and hearing, allow the exceptions, and upon re-

8 quest of the moving party, order the official stenographer 9 to furnish a certified copy of the evidence required under 10 the motion or appeal, and such portion thereof as may be 11 made a part of the exceptions.
