STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of repairing bridge in town of Amity.

*Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of three hundred dollars (\$300) for the purpose of
3 repairing a bridge across Davis stream in the town of
4 Amity; said appropriation to be expended under the super-
5 vision of the State Highway Department.*

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This town of Amity carries a population of 375 with a total valuation of \$98,000.00. In addition to the bridge mentioned in the foregoing resolve this town has six other bridges to maintain. The total expense of maintaining the bridge in question, with the six other bridges, for the year 1913 will be \$850.00, as estimated by the municipal officers of the town of Amity.
