STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Repairing Highway in town of
Somerville.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of five hundred dollars (\$500) for the purpose of repairing
3 the county road in the town of Somerville, Lincoln county,
4 leading from Jefferson town line through South Somerville
5 to Washington town line; said sum to be expended under
6 the supervision of the State Highway Department.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This road is about two and one-half miles in length and accommodates the travel between Washington and the railroad at Cooper's Mills. It is in bad condition, and the town is not able to do much more than keep it passable. It could be put in very good condition with this appropriation.
