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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

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AN ACT to extend the rights, powers and privileges of the  
Barrows Falls Light and Power Company.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Bar-  
rows Falls Light and Power Company which were granted  
by chapter two hundred and sixty-three of the Private and  
Special Laws of the year nineteen hundred and nine, and  
extended by chapter two hundred and sixty-seven of the  
Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and eleven,  
are hereby extended for and during the period of two years  
from the date on which this act takes effect, and the rights,  
powers and privileges that were granted by said act may  
and shall be exercised in the same manner and for the same  
purposes as provided in said act.
