STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Central Maine Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. The action of said Central Maine Power Com2 pany in purchasing the plants, property, rights, privileges
3 and franchises of the Waterville & Fairfield Railway &
4 Light Company, the Union Gas & Electric Company, the
5 Bingham Electric Company, the Clinton Electric Company, the
6 the Dexter Electric Company, the Kennebec Light & Heat
7 Company and the Vassalborough Electric Light & Power
8 Company is hereby ratified, approved and declared legal
9 and valid, and said Central Maine Power Company shall

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10 have, possess, exercise and enjoy in its own name all said 11 plants, property, rights, privileges and franchises as though 12 originally granted to it, except that it shall have no author-13 ity to issue further stocks, securities or obligations of any 14 kind in the name of any of said companies.

Sect. 2. The Waterville & Fairfield Railway & Light 2 Company and the Union Gas & Electric Company or either 3 of them may be dissolved in accordance with law.
