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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

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AN ACT to amend Chapter one hundred and seventy-three of  
the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-  
seven, relating to the Cornish Village Improvement Society,  
and to make valid the organization of said Society incorpo-  
rated under said Chapter.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section one of chapter one hundred and seventy-three of  
2 the private and special acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-  
3 seven is hereby amended as follows: strike out the words  
4 "northerly line of lands of and John P. Bradeen" in the  
5 eleventh line of said section and insert the word 'land' after  
6 the word "Thompson," and strike out the words "crossing  
7 said road to the northeast" in the twelfth and thirteenth

8 lines of said section and insert in place thereof the words  
9 'by and across said road to the southerly,' so that said sec-  
10 tion as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The territory embraced within the following  
12 limits; beginning on the west bank of Saco river, at the  
13 northeasterly corner of land of Elihu Parker, and thence  
14 running westerly by land of said Parker to land of heirs  
15 of James T. King; thence southerly by easterly line of said  
16 heirs' land to land of Isaac Small; thence westerly by said  
17 Small's land to county road leading from Cornish village  
18 to Limington; thence northwesterly, crossing said road to  
19 the northwesterly line of land of M. S. Eastman; thence  
20 southerly on line of said Eastman's land to land of William  
21 W. Thompson; thence by said Thompson's land to the old  
22 Limerick road, so called; thence by and across said road to  
23 the southerly corner of land of heirs of James T. King;  
24 thence westerly by the southerly line of said heirs' land to  
25 land of Willis Warren; thence by line of said Warren's land  
26 to the new Limerick road, so called; thence crossing said  
27 road to the southerly line of land of Thomas J. Richardson;  
28 thence by said Richardson's southerly and westerly line to  
29 the westerly line of school district number two; thence fol-  
30 lowing the line of said district to the place of beginning,  
31 in the town of Cornish, together with the inhabitants thereof,  
32 be, and the same hereby is created a body politic and cor-  
33 porate by the name of the Cornish Village Improvement  
34 Society.'

Sect. 2. The organization of the Cornish Village Improve-  
2 ment Society, under chapter one hundred and seventy-three  
3 of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and  
4 eighty-seven, is hereby made valid and all its past acts are  
5 hereby made valid and legal.
