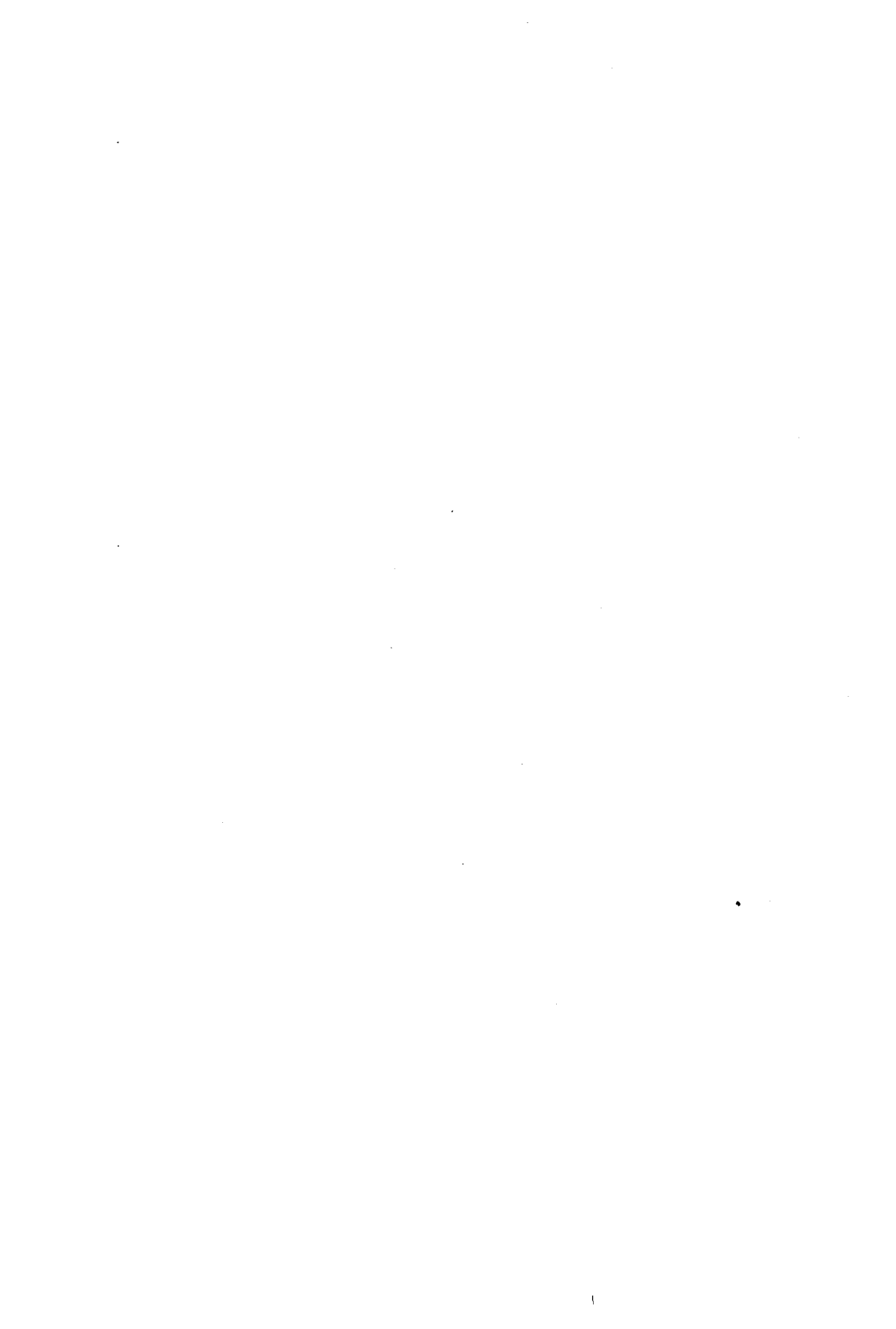

STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of a survey for a bridge between Madawaska, Me., and Edmunston, N. B.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of three hundred dollars (\$300) for the purpose of
3 making survey and plans for a bridge between Madawaska,
4 Me., and Edmunston, N. B.; said appropriation to be ex-
5 pended, and said survey and plans to be made, by the State
6 Highway Department.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

It is not deemed advisable at this time to recommend an appropriation for the construction of a bridge, but the importance of the matter is such that the committee considers it necessary that a survey and plans, estimate, etc., be made as soon as practicable.
