STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of an appropriation to complete the historical record of Maine men serving in the United States Navy during the War for the Suppression of the Rebellion, 1861-1865.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) 2 for the year 1913 is hereby appropriated to be expended 3 under the direction of the Governor and Council in com-4 pleting the historical record of residents of the State of 5 Maine who had service in the United States Navy during 6 the War for the Suppression of the Rebellion, 1861-1865. 7 Any portion of the appropriation remaining unexpended on 8 December 31, 1913, shall be carried forward and be avail-9 able for expenditure in the year 1914.

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STATEMENT OF FACTS.

While the records of the State of Maine are very complete regarding those who had service in the United States Volunteers during the Civil War, the record of Maine men who had service in the United States Navy is very incomplete.

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
