STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to the transportation of fish taken in waters in Davis Town, Stetson Town, Seven Ponds Town and Massachusetts Gore, so called, in Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person at any
time to carry away or transport in any way any fish taken
in any of the following named waters: In any of the waters
situated in Davis Town, Stetson Town, Seven Ponds Town
or Massachusetts Gore, so called, all in the county of Frank-6 lin.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this

2 act shall pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than
3 thirty dollars for each offense and a further fine of one
4 dollar for each fish transported in violation of any pro5 visions of this act.
