STATE OF MAINE

---

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

---

AN ACT relating to the transportation of fish taken in waters in Davis Town, Stetson Town, Seven Ponds Town and Massachusetts Gore, so called, in Franklin County.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person at any  
2 time to carry away or transport in any way any fish taken  
3 in any of the following named waters: In any of the waters  
4 situated in Davis Town, Stetson Town, Seven Ponds Town  
5 or Massachusetts Gore, so called, all in the county of Frank-  
6 lin.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this

2 act shall pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than  
3 thirty dollars for each offense and a further fine of one  
4 dollar for each fish transported in violation of any pro-  
5 visions of this act.
