STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to regulate and establish mileage rates for the conveyance of passengers over the steam railroads within the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All railroad corporations or companies doing
2 business in this state and conveying passengers over any
3 road or roads owned or operated by them and whose motive
4 power is steam, whether owned or operated by them in
5 their own or other names, under lease or otherwise, which
6 now, or hereafter may, issue a mileage ticket of one thou-
7 sand one-mile coupons for the use of the traveling public
8 and keep the same on sale at their regular passenger sta-

9 tions, shall also issue a mileage ticket of five hundred one-
10 mile coupons, and sell the same at all stations where the
11 one thousand mile ticket is now, or hereafter may, be sold,
12 at the same rate per mile as the one thousand mile ticket
13 may be sold. The holder of any such mileage ticket shall
14 be entitled to travel, by any regular passenger train, over
15 the road issuing the same as many miles as there are cou-
16 pons contained in such ticket.

Provided, however, that the minimum mileage to be de-
18 tached shall be regulated by the printed contract contained
19 in such ticket.
