STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to enlarge the powers of the Scarboro Water Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. The Scarboro Water Company, incorporated
2 under chapter 459 of the Private and Special Laws of
3 Maine, approved March 21, 1901, is hereby authorized to
4 make, generate, sell, distribute and supply gas for lighting,
5 heating, manufacturing, and mechanical purposes, and to
6 supply that part of the town of Scarboro known as Higgins
7 Beach, and which is located east of a line running from the

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8 southeasterly corner of land of James C. Jordan on the coast o at the southerly end of Higgins Beach, and by the east side 10 of said Jordan's land, thence due north, and the inhabitants 11 thereof, with gas light, and to carry on the business of light-12 ing by gas such public streets in the territory aforesaid, and 13 such buildings and places therein, public and private, as may 14 be agreed upon by said corporation, and the owners, or those 15 having control of such places to be lighted; and may build 16 and operate factories and works for providing and supply-17 ing gas; and may lay, maintain, and operate lines of pipe 18 for the transmission of gas, upon, along, and over any and 10 all streets and ways under the direction of the municipal 20 offiers of said town, provided that the granting of this char-21 ter shall in no way interfere with the right of any other par-22 ties or companies to supply the above described territory 23 with gas.

Sect. 2. Said corporation may establish written regulations 2 for the use of its gas as aforesaid, and change the same from 3 time to time.

Sect. 3. Section 2 of chapter 459 of the Private and Spe-2 cial Laws of 1901 is hereby amended by striking out the 3 word "five" in the third line thereof, and inserting the word 4 'twenty,' so that said section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Said corporation may take and hold by purchase 6 or otherwise real and personal estate necessary and con-7 venient for any of the purposes aforesaid, to the amount of 8 twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000).' Sect. 4. Section 10 of chapter 459 of the Private and Spe-2 cial Laws of 1901 is hereby amended by striking out the 3 word "five" in the second line thereof, and inserting the 4 word 'twenty' in place thereof, so that said section shall read 5 as follows:

'Sect. 10. The capital stock of said corporation shall not 7 exceed twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000), and the stock 8 shall be divided into shares of one hundred dollars (\$100) 9 each.'
