STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section one hundred two of Chapter fifteen
of the Revised Statutes relating to the preparation of blank
forms by the State Superintendent of Public Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Section 1. Section one hundred two of chapter fifteen of
2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out all
3 words after the word "return" in the fourth line thereof
4 and substituting in place thereof the following: 'as provided
5 by section thirty-seven and shall, on the first day of each
6 May, forward to said superintendent blanks for the returns
7 required by section thirty-eight," so that said section when
8 amended shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 102. He shall prepare and print blank forms for all
10 other returns required by law, or deemed by him necessary,
11 and shall, on the first day of each March, forward to the
12 superintendents of schools of the several towns, blanks for
13 the annual school return as provided by section thirty-seven,
14 and shall, on the first day of each May, forward to said
15 superintendents blanks for the returns required by section
16 thirty-eight.’
