STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter ninety-three of the Revised Statutes, as amended by Chapter eighty-six of the Public Laws of 1911, relating to the recording of personal property mortgages and sales.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: The last sentence of section one of chapter ninety-three of 2 the Revised Statutes as amended by chapter eighty-six of 3 the Public Laws of 1911 is hereby amended so that said 4 last sentence of said section shall read as follows:

'If any mortgagor resides in an unorganized place the mort-6 gage shall be recorded in the oldest adjoining town or plan-7 tation, organized as aforesaid, in the county, provided there

8 be a town or plantation in the county organized as aforesaid 9 adjoining such unorganized place, and if there be no such 10 adjoining town or plantation organized as aforesaid in the 11 county, such mortgage shall be recorded in the office of the 12 register of deeds for the registry district in which such un-13 incorporated place is located.'
