STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT additional to Chapter twenty-eight of the Revised
Statutes for the Prevention of False Fire Alarms.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Whoever knowingly and wilfully gives or
2 causes to be given a false alarm of fire in any city, town
3 or village corporation maintaining an organized fire depart-
4 ment, shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of
5 not more than fifty dollars.

Sect. 2. Judges of police and municipal courts, trial jus-
2 tices shall have jurisdiction of all violations of this act with-
3 in their counties.
