STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 393 of the Private and Special Laws of 1909.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 14 of chapter 393 of the Private and Special Laws
2 of 1909, is hereby amended by striking out the words "said
3 town of" in the seventh line, and the word "Millinocket"
4 in the eighth line, and inserting in the place thereof the
5 words 'The county of Penobscot,' and by striking out the
6 word "town" in the eleventh line, and inserting in the place
7 thereof the word 'county,' so that said section as amended

8 shall read as follows:

HOUSE-No. 512.

'Sect. 14. The town of Millinocket may, if it shall so vote, 10 at any regularly held town meeting, provide a suitable court 11 room in said Millinocket, conveniently situated and appro-12 priately fitted up and furnished, in which to hold said court, 13 and keep the same in proper condition for use, and it shall 14 be deemed and denominated the court room, though used 15 also for other purposes if approved by the judge. The 16 county of Penobscot shall provide for said court an appro-17 priate seal and all blanks, blank books, dockets, stationery, 18 and other things necessary for the transaction of its busi-19 ness; and said county is hereby authorized to appropriate 20 money therefor.'

Section 15 of chapter 393 is hereby amended by striking 22 out the word "one" in line three of said section, and insert-23 ing in the place thereof the word 'four,' so that said section 24 as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect 15. 'The judge shall receive a salary in full for all 26 services of six hundred dollars per annum to be paid him 27 by the county of Penobscot, and the recorder a salary of 28 four hundred dollars per annum paid quarterly.'

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
