RESOLVE in favor of a feeding pond at the Knox County
Hatchery, at Camden, Maine.

*Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the
2 sum of five hundred dollars for the year 1913, the same to
3 be expended by the commissioners of inland fisheries and
4 game, under the direction of the governor and council, for
5 the purpose of building a feeding pond for fish at the Knox
6 County Fish Hatchery, at Camden, Maine.*

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

It is much desired that suitable feeding ponds be constructed at the Camden Hatchery, in order that a larger number of fish may be fed at this hatchery and liberated as fingerlings or yearlings.

The present capacity of this hatchery permits this to be done only to a limited extent—it being necessary now to plant the majority of the fish soon after hatching.
