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Balance due	\$400 13

On west side:

Iron screen 21 feet long, average length of 9 feet.

Iron screen 12 feet long, average length of 5 feet.

Two cement abutments, 5 feet high, 18 in. square.

On cement abutment, 6 feet high, 12 feet long, 20 in. wide.

On east side:

Iron screen 23 feet long, average length 14 feet.

One cement abutment, 7 feet high, 8 feet long, 20 in. square.

One cement abutment, 6 feet high, 30 feet long, 20 in. wide.
