STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to the insurance of property owned by the
State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whenever any state officer or state department has taken
2 out fire insurance on property owned by the state or for
3 which the state is responsible, payable to the state treas-
4 urer, and said property has been destroyed, the money paid
5 by the insurance companies on the loss shall, with the ap-
6 proval of the governor and council, be made immediately
7 available for the use of such office or department in replac-
8 ing the destroyed property, or otherwise as may be needed
9 in furthering the work of the office or department.
