STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section thirty-six of Chapter fifteen of the
Revised Statutes as amended in relation to the accurate keep-
ing of school records and accounts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section thirty-six of chapter fifteen of the Re-
vised Statutes, as amended by chapter forty-eight of the
Public Laws of nineteen hundred five is hereby further
amended by inserting after the word "committee" in the
second line thereof the following: 'he shall keep a perma-
nent record of all its votes, orders and proceedings, he shall
place all orders for materials and supplies purchased by vote
of the committee and shall be its agent in keeping all finan-

9 cial records and accounts. He shall issue vouchers show-
10 ing the correctness of bills contracted on account of school
11 appropriations, but such bills shall not be allowed for pay-
12 ment by the municipal officers of towns unless they shall
13 have been approved by a majority of the members of the
14 superintending school committee', and by striking out the
15 word "and" in the third line thereof and substituting in
16 place thereof the word 'he', so that said section when amend-
17 ed shall read as follows:

'Sect. 36. The superintendent of schools in every town
19 shall be, ex-officio, secretary of the superintending school
20 committee. He shall keep a permanent record of all its
21 votes, orders and proceedings, he shall place all orders for
22 materials and supplies purchased by vote of the committee
23 and shall be its agent in keeping all financial records and
24 accounts. He shall issue vouchers showing the correctness
25 of bills contracted on account of school appropriations, but
26 such bills shall not be allowed for payment by the municipal
27 officers of towns unless they shall have been approved by a
28 majority of the members of the superintending school com-
29 mittee. He shall perform such duties not herein enumerated
30 as said committee shall direct.'
