# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to incorporate Readfield Chamber of Commerce.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. Leon O. Tebbetts, J. Orville Newton, Elfsworth
2 E. Peacock and such other persons as desire to associate
3 themselves with the aforesaid are hereby constituted, in
4 body politic and corporate by the name of the Readfield
5 Chamber of Commerce.

Sect. 2. The objects of the new corporation shall be to 2 advance industry, commerce and public interests of the town 3 of Readfield and vicinity.

Sect. 3. The said corporation shall have power to estab-2 lish suitable by-laws, to carry out all powers herein granted,

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3 including provisions as to the admission, suspension and 4 expulsion of members and delegation of powers to offices, 5 committee and directors.

Sect. 4. The officers of the corporation shall consist of a 2 president, one or more vice presidents and such other offi-3 cers as may be determined by the by-laws. The officers 4 shall hold their offices for the length of time fixed by their 5 by-laws, and shall have and exercise all powers prescribed 6 in such by-laws.

Sect. 5. The first meeting of said corporation shall be 2 called by a notice signed by one of the incorporators named 3 in section one, mailed to each one of the other incorporators 4 at least seven days before said meeting, or notice of said 5 meeting may be waived by written consent of said incor-6 porators.
