STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE relating to repairs and improvements of Capitol Building and Grounds.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of seven thousand dollars to be expended during the
3 year nineteen hundred and thirteen in repairing and im-
4 proving the Capitol Building and grounds, as follows:

5	Painting	\$2,000 00
6	Repairing roof	1,000 00
7	Weather strips	850 00
8	Improving grounds	500 00
9	Renewing floor in pension office.....	150 00
10	Treasurer's vault, general repairs and furnish-	
11	ings in Treasury Department.....	2,500 00

Said appropriation to be expended under the supervision of
13 the superintendent of public buildings.

Should any part of the appropriation remain unexpended
15 at the end of said year it shall not lapse but may be ex-
16 pended in the succeeding year.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The above appropriation is needed for repairs and improvements on the Capitol Building and grounds for the following purposes: Painting, repairing roof, weather strips, improving grounds, renewing floor in pension office, treasurer's vault, and general repairs and furnishings in Treasury Department.
