STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 51 of Chapter 28 of the Revised
Statutes relating to investigations of fires and inspection of
buildings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 51 of chapter 28 of the Revised Stat-
utes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sect. 51. The insurance commissioner may employ such
clerks and assistants, provide such blanks and incur such
expense as may be necessary to carry out his duties in in-
vestigating or causing to be investigated the origin of fires
and the inspection of buildings and property, not to exceed
an amount equal to twenty-five per cent of the fees received

9 from fire insurance companies, with twenty-five per cent of
10 the amount received by the state treasurer for tax on special
11 insurance brokers and twenty-five per cent of the tax on
12 unauthorized insurance in any year and all bills and ex-
13 penses incurred shall be audited by the state auditor.'
