STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to the protection of deer in the town of
Isle au Haut, in Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Whoever hunts, takes, catches, kills or destroys
2 any deer in the town of Isle au Haut, in Hancock county,
3 shall pay a fine of forty dollars and costs for each offense.
