STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Mellen Tryon, Secretary of the Com-
mittee on Maine School for Feeble-Minded.

Resolved, That the sum of thirty-two dollars and sixty-two
2 cents be paid to Mellen Tryon, secretary of the committee
3 on Maine School for Feeble-Minded, for expenses incurred
4 by the committee in visiting the institution and investigating
5 the same.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

On January 23, the committee visited the School for Feeble-Minded at West Pownal. On February 7, a sub-committee of three went to West Pownal to find out about the water supply. The amount paid for mileages was twenty-two dollars and twelve cents; for electric car fares, five dollars and fifty cents. The committee also paid C. R. Tupper five dollars for services rendered in investigating the affairs of the institution. The total amount of these expenses is thirty-two dollars and sixty-two cents.
