STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Androscoggin Anti-Tuberculosis

Association.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be, and 2 hereby is appropriated to be paid to the Androscoggin Anti-3 Tuberculosis Association for the year nineteen hundred and 4 thirteen, and five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hun-5 dred and fourteen to be used in the charitable work of said 6 association for the relief and control of tuberculosis.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Since the organization of the Androscoggin Anti-Tuberculosis Association in 1910 the expenses have exceeded \$100 per month for drugs, milk, rent, light, laundry and sundry expenses.

No salaries have been paid except for nursing at \$55 per month.

Received from the state per year	\$500
From Lewiston	300
From Auburn	150

Have paid the balance and bought land for a sanatorium costing \$700 from individual contributions and from organizations, clubs, sale of Red Cross seals, etc.

The demand for our service is constantly increasing yet our efforts must of necessity be retarded if we fail to secure this appropriation as in years past.

Whereas this association, since its inception, has extended its work to not only the county of Androscoggin but the adjacent territory we pray that our request may be granted.
