RESOLVE in favor of York Hospital, in the town of York.

*Resolved:* That there be and hereby is appropriated the  
2 sum of twelve hundred dollars to be paid to the York Hos-  
3 pital, in the town of York, for the year nineteen hundred and  
4 thirteen and twelve hundred dollars for the year nineteen  
5 hundred and fourteen, for maintenance.



## STATEMENT OF FACTS RELATING TO YORK HOSPITAL.

The York Hospital is a public institution located in the town of York, and serves a large district in the southwestern part of the State. It consists of two substantial buildings especially adapted to hospital work, and well equipped throughout. It is open all the year and to all persons alike, whether rich or poor.

Of the 61 patients treated last year, there were medical patients 38, surgical 14, and obstetrical 9. Of all these 31 were charitable.

The hospital gave 229 free days to patients.

Of the \$9129.49 expenditure only \$986.40 was received from patients.

The items of receipts were as follows:

Received from patients .....	\$986 40
Received from donations from residents and summer visitors .....	4443 09
Received from district nurse fund (charitable) .....	1100 00
State appropriation last year .....	1000 00
Town of York .....	1500 00

Appropriations asked for, \$1500 for the year 1913 and \$1500 for the year 1914.
