STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Daughters of Wisdom, St. Agatha.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of five hundred dollars to be paid to the Daughters of
3 Wisdom, St. Agatha, for the year nineteen hundred and
4 thirteen, and five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hun-
5 dred and fourteen, for maintenance.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Daughters of Wisdom's Hospital situated in the town of St. Agatha, received its first appropriation from the State in the year nineteen hundred and eleven. The amount appropriated was one thousand dollars (\$1,000) five hundred dollars (\$500) for the year nineteen hundred and eleven and five hundred dollars (\$500) for the year nineteen hundred twelve.

The hospital is managed by the Sisters, who seeked refuge in this country when expelled from France a few years ago. As informed by the Mother Superior of this institution a considerable number of patients were treated gratis each year on account of lack of funds and the incapacity of the patients to pay their expenses. As furthermore informed their services were given free, this is no hindrance to them as caring for the sick is part of their vows.

They are now building an addition to the hospital and do not feel capable of continuing the good work unless the State lends a helping hand.
