HOUSE AMENDMENT A TO SENATE DOCUMENT
NUMBER 385.

Amend Senate Document No. 385 by striking out after the
2 word "proposed" in the third line thereof the lines 4 to 11
3 inclusive and inserting in place thereof the following:

Section 8 of Article 19 of the constitution is hereby amend-
5 ed by adding to said section the following words: 'But the
6 legislature shall have power to levy a tax upon intangible
7 personal property at such rate as it deems wise and equitable
8 without regard to the rate applied to other classes of prop-
9 erty,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 8. All taxes upon real and personal estate, assessed
11 by authority of this state, shall be apportioned and assessed

12 equally, according to the just value thereof ; but the legis-
13 lature shall have power to levy a tax upon intangible per-
14 sonal property at such rate as it deems wise and equitable
15 without regard to the rate applied to other classes of prop-
16 erty.'
