STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend "An Act to incorporate the Livermore Falls Sewer District," as amended by Chapter 441 of the Private and Special Laws of 1907 and as amended by Chapter 185 of the Private and Special Laws of 1911.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section eight of chapter two hundred and

- 2 eighty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of 1907 is here-
- 3 by amended by striking out the words "one hundred" in the
- 4 last line of said section and inserting in place thereof the
- 5 words 'fifty' and adding thereto the following: 'At the close
- 6 of each fiscal year the trustees shall make a detailed report
- 7 of their doings, of the receipts and expenditures of said

8 sewer district, of its financial and physical condition and of 9 such other matters and things pertaining to said district as 10 shall show the inhabitants of said district how said trustees 11 are fulfilling the duties and obligations of their trust, such 12 report to be made and filed with the municipal officers of 13 the town of East Livermore, by the first of February in 14 each year,' so that said section when amended shall read as 15 follows:

'Sect. 8. All the affairs of said sewer district shall be managed by a board of trustees composed of three members, all to be residents of said district, to be chosen by the selectmen of the town of East Livermore, but no member of the board of selectmen shall during the term for which he is elected be chosen one of said board of trustees. As soon as convenient after the members of said board have been chosen, said trustees shall hold a meeting at the office of the selectmen in the town of East Livermore, and organize by the election of a president and clerk, adopt a corporate seal and when necessary choose a treasurer and all other needful officers and agents, for the proper conduct and management of the affairs of said district.

'At said first meeting they shall determine by lot the term 30 of office of each trustee so that one shall serve for one year, 31 one for two years, and one for three years; and when the 32 term of office of a trustee expires, the said selectmen of the 33 town of East Livermore shall appoint a successor to serve 34 the full term of three years; and in case of any other va-

35 cancy arising, it shall be filled in like manner for the un-36 expired term. They may also ordain and establish such 37 by-laws as are necessary for their own convenience and the 38 proper management of the affairs of the district.

The term of office of trustee shall begin on the first Mon-40 day of May. Said trustees may procure an office and incur 41 such expense as may be necessary. Each member shall re-42 ceive in full compensation for his services an allowance of 43 fifty dollars per annum.

At the close of his fiscal year the trustees shall make a detailed report of their doings, of the receipts and expendition and said sewer district, of its financial and physical condition, and of such other matters and things pertaining to 48 said district as shall show the inhabitants of said district how said trustees are fulfilling the duties and obligations of their trust, such report to be made and filed with the munitipal officers of the town of East Livermore by the first of February in each year.'
