STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to provide for the election of officers in cities by
plurality vote.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. In all elections in cities by the people, the
2 candidate receiving the greatest number of votes for any
3 municipal office, although such number is not a majority
4 of all the votes cast, shall be deemed elected to such office.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts and all provisions of
2 all city charters inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when any city at a reg-
2 ular or special election shall adopt the same by a majority
3 vote.
