STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Commission on enlargement of State House.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of eight thousand dollars to be paid as follows:

Charles S. Hichborn, twenty-five hundred dollars,

Charles W. Mullen, fifteen hundred dollars,

Don A. H. Powers, fifteen hundred dollars,

Frank D. True, fifteen hundred dollars,

7 for their services as members of the Commission of the 8 enlargement of the State House.

And the further sum of one thousand dollars be appro-10 priated and paid to Roy H. Bodwell for services as clerk 11 of said commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Charles S. Hichborn, Charles W. Mullen, Don A. H. Powers and Frank D. True were appointed by Governor Fernald, a commission to enlarge and remodel the State House, said commission organized with a choice of Charles S. Hichborn as chairman, Roy H. Bodwell was employed as clerk. The work was completed within the prescribed time and within the appropriation and they had never received pay from the State for their services.
