In Senate, March 27, 1913.

Ordered, That a committee of three, on the part of the Senate, with such as the House may join, be appointed to consider and to report the order of proceedings to be observed upon the hearing proposed by the resolve of the two branches upon the alleged causes of removal in the case of Lewis W. Moulton, sheriff for the county of Cumberland; and that the Secretary of the Senate be directed to issue due subpoenas for the summoning of witnesses to be present and testify at such hearing, upon application of either prosecution or defence, and that counsel be furnished either party.
