STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE waiving a forfeiture of the Public Lots in the north half of Township Number Twenty-seven, Washington County, Eastern Division.

Resolved, That the forfeitures of the rights to the timber and grass on the public lots in the north half of township number twenty-seven, Washington county, eastern division, for alleged non-payment of taxes, are hereby waived and the owners thereof of record are restored to their rights therein as fully as if record of said forfeiture had not been made; provided, however, that the owner or owners shall pay all taxes which have been assessed, or should have been assessed, with interest thereon, to date.

Due record of this waiver shall be made in the offices of 11 the state treasurer, the land agent and the board of state 12 assessors.
