STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

HOUSE AMENDMENT "E," SENATE DOCUMENT 2 NO. 575, is hereby amended by striking out section eleven 3 thereof and inserting in place thereof the following:

The governor shall, with the advice and consent of the 5 council, appoint some suitable person a commissioner under 6 this act who shall hold office for three years from date of 7 appointment and unless removed, as hereunder provided. 8 shall hold office until his successor is appointed and quali-9 fied. Such commissioner shall be sworn and for inefficiency, 10 wilful neglect of duty or for malfeasance in office, may 11 after notice and hearing be removed from office by the gov-12 ernor and council. In case of vacancy occurring through 13 death, resignation or removal, the governor shall, with the

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14 advice and consent of the council, appoint a successor for 15 the whole term of three years, subject to removal as afore-16 said. Such commissioner shall receive a salary of three 17 thousand dollars per annum. He shall also receive traveling 18 and other expenses actually and necessarily incurred in the 19 performance of his duties.'

Said bill is further amended by striking out the word "com-21 mission" whenever it appears in the bill and substituting the 22 word 'commissioner' and by making such further gram-23 matical changes as may be found necessary by so substi-24 tuting said word 'commissioner.'
