STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend section fifty of chapter fifty-one of the Revised Statutes as amended by chapter 165 of the Public Laws of 1911 relating to duties of the Railroad Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 50 of chapter 51 of the Revised Statutes as amended by chapter 165 of the Public Laws of 1911, is hereby further amended by striking out in the first and second lines of said section the words, "a majority of the board or one member thereof" and substituting in place thereof the words 'a member of said board or some person appointed for the purpose, by said board;' and also insert

8 before the word "shall" in the fifth line of said section the
9 words 'said board;' so that said section as amended shall
10 read as follows:

'Sect. 50. A member of said board or some person ap-
12 pointed for the purpose by said board, annually, between
13 the first of April and October, and at any other time on
14 application or whenever they think necessary, shall care-
15 fully examine the tracks, rolling stock, bridges, viaducts
16 and culverts of all railroads; and said board shall annually
17 in December make a report to the governor of their official
18 doings, therein stating the condition of the road and rolling
19 stock, with such facts as they deem of public interest or
20 which he may require; and all persons managing railroads
21 shall give the board such information as they at any time
22 require.'
