AN ACT relating to the Fort Kent Electric Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Fort Kent Electric Company, a corporation duly organized by law and located at Fort Kent in the County of Aroostook and State of Maine, is hereby authorized to make, generate, sell, distribute and supply gas or electricity, or both, for lighting, heating, manufacturing or mechanical purposes, in the town of Fort Kent, in the County of Aroostook, and also in the plantations of Allagash, St. Francis, St. John, Wallagrass and Eagle Lake, all in said County of Aroostook.
