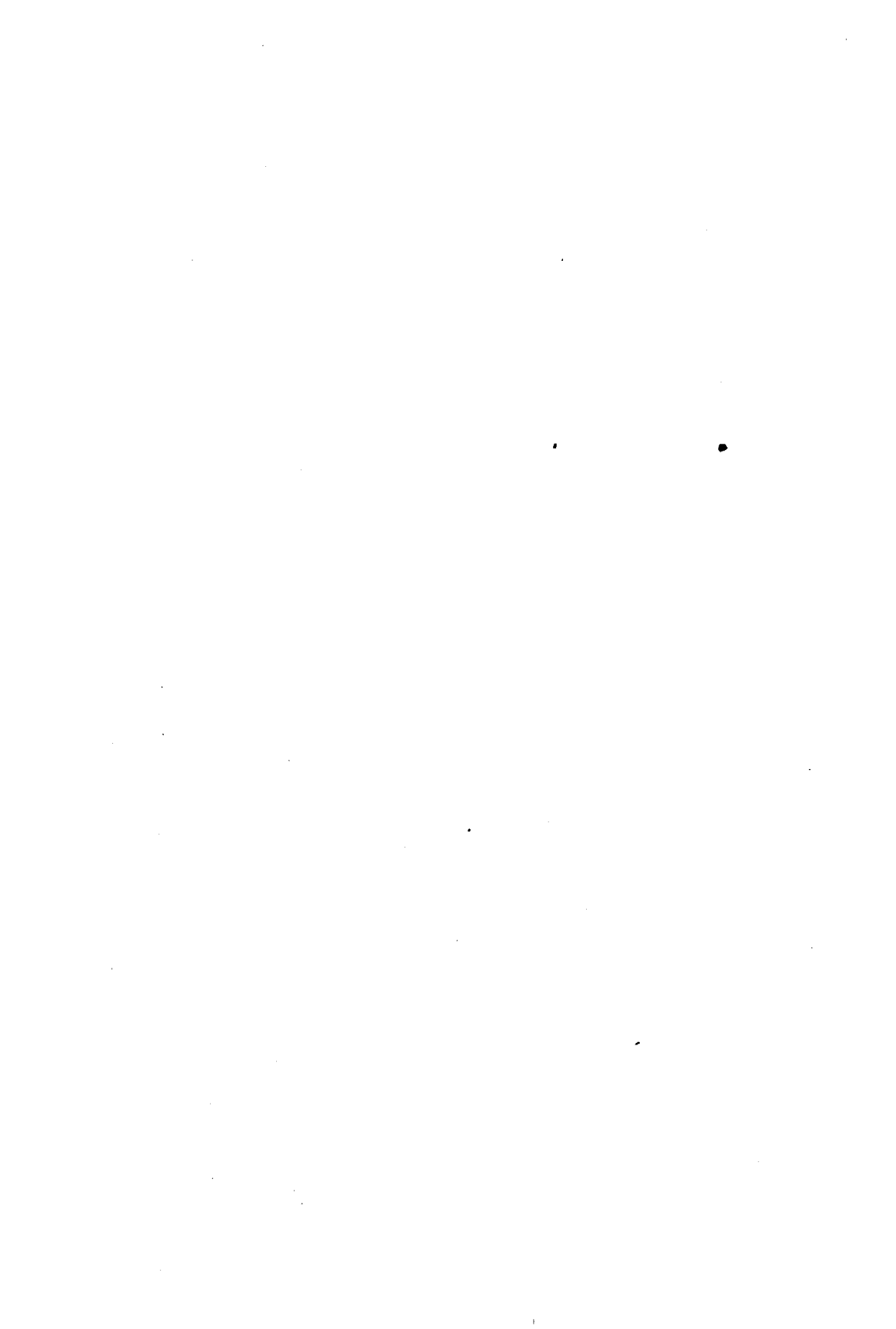

RESOLVE in favor of the Town of Eagle Lake.

Resolved, That there be appropriated the sum of two thousand
2 sand dollars (\$2,000) for the construction of a road in the
3 town of Eagle Lake, for the year of 1913. The construc-
4 tion of the road to be under the supervision of the state
5 highway department.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Five families have farms cleared in a measure in the forest two miles from the nearest road in Eagle Lake. There is no way at present of reaching these farms, except over private property. If a highway was constructed numerous other people would take up land and clear it for farms. The town of Eagle Lake will donate the right of way.
